



## CECONY 867 From and To Dates

As part of the CC&B implementation, dates (DTM150/DTM151) sent on usage and invoice transactions via EDI will be mapped to usage dates (rather than bill period dates). CC&B is a usage-based billing system and we are looking at metered usage from midnight to midnight.

For example, if the bill period is 10/11 – 11/11, the data that we bill really starts 10/12 at 12:01 AM (to encompass the FULL day of data on 10/12) and ends 11/12 at 12:00 AM (to encompass the full day of data on 11/11). So, the usage dates reported will be 10/12 - 11/12.

### Please note the following:

- This change only impacts CECONY. ORU/RECO already uses the usage dates concept.
- There is no missing usage for given period.
- The “shift” in date is only evident on the transition bill. The first “from” date will not match the last “to” date you on the last file you were sent.
- Bill periods provided in the 867HU that were generated prior to the CCB Cutover will also have this “shift”
