

September 2023 UFE – Potential Revision

We are writing to inform you of a reporting error in Con Edison Zone J generation that occurred for the month of September 2023, which will impact your NYISO billing/re-billing once the issue is resolved at FERC. Further details regarding this incident can be found in the [FERC filing linked here](#).

Your current NYISO bill was calculated using a lower hourly Unaccounted for Energy (UFE) due to the misreported lower generation. The UFE utilized averaged 2.52% instead of the newly estimated 6.5% pending FERC's approval of the waiver. In terms of MWh, the expected increase corresponds to the amount of generation misreported for the month of September 2023, and no other months are impacted.

Consolidated Edison has requested a waiver for the reconciliation period from the FERC. The new TOL (Transmission Owner Load) to be submitted to the NYISO will encompass all cancellations and re-bills for your customers up to the date of the new submission.

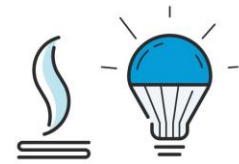
