







Kent Avenue Generating Station Site History

- Operated 1905-1989 as power generating station (coal ash/water mixture pumped to ash pit); electric distribution until 1998
- Original Williamsburg power plant demolished in 1950s
- Remaining power plant was abated for asbestos/lead paint and demolished in 2007-2009
- July 2010 Voluntary Cleanup Agreement (VCA) with NYSDEC for the entire Site
- Former National Grid Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) located adjacent to south property line









- Closure: Dec. 5 21
- Removal of Temporary Facilities: Dec. 14 Jan. 6
- Work Hours: 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM
