Sidewalks of South Water Street, Main Street and Secor Road – Ossining Gas Works MGP Site

Remediation Project – Soil Boring and Monitoring Well Installation

Tuesday, October 23, 2018

As part of the manufactured gas plant (MGP) remediation program, Con Edison will be installing two to four soil borings and one to two groundwater monitoring wells in the area described above in order to further delineate the extent of coal tar contaminants beneath the ground.

This area is located near the site of the former Ossining MGP, which operated during 1850s – 1940s. Prior investigations at the site show limited MGP impacts beneath the ground within the DPW property and commuter parking lot. Work procedures approved by the NYSDEC and the New York State Department of Health, including a community air monitoring plan, will be put in place, and there is not expected to be any health impact to the local community.
