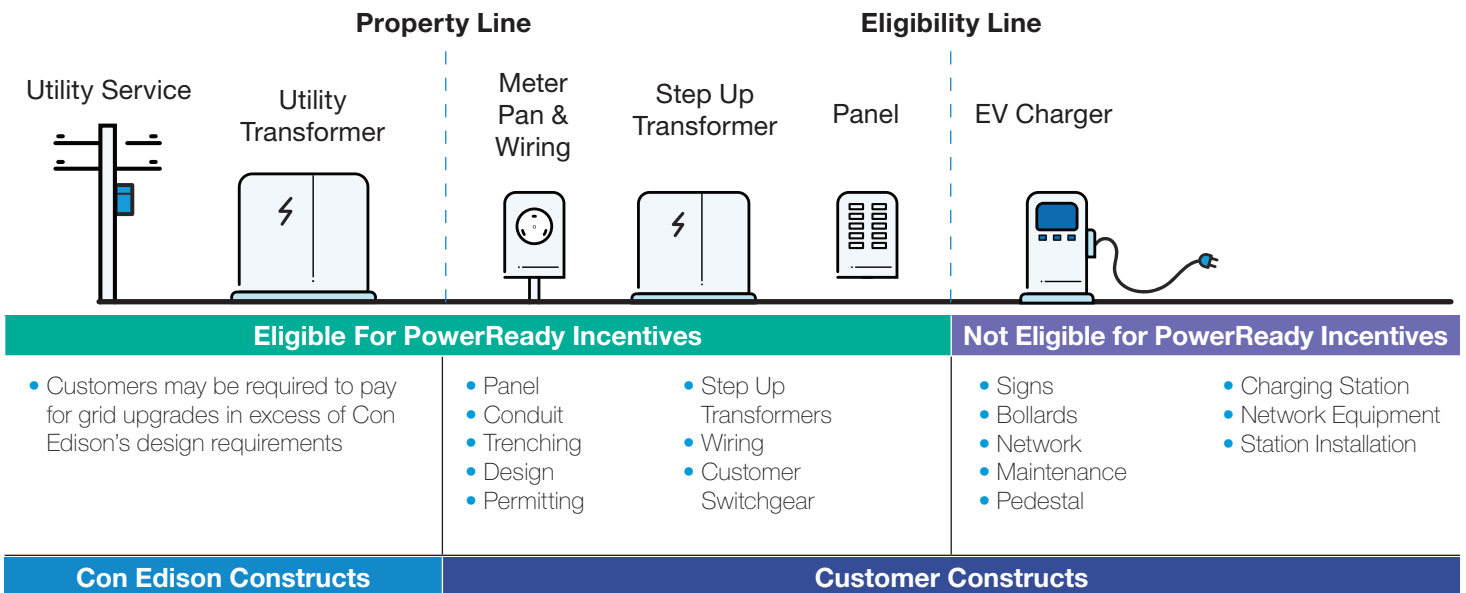
For Buildings, Businesses, and Parking Areas

Installing EV chargers can help you get ready for the millions of new electric vehicle drivers that are expected to hit the road. Here's why:

- **Get A Building That Wows:** EV charging is an amenity that can entice and retain residents, employees, or customers, plus demonstrate your commitment to sustainability. Chargers can also help you earn points towards your Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) certification.
- **Turn Your Parking Lot into a Paradise:** Emission- and noise-free EVs make underground and enclosed parking structures much more pleasant. Plus, parking spaces equipped with EV chargers have a higher revenue potential than those without.

What's Eligible?

Everything up to the charger pedestal or mount is eligible for incentives through the PowerReady Program.



How Much is Covered?

Tiered incentives are available to cover both utility-side and customer-side costs depending on eligibility criteria.

	Private Sites	Public Sites
Proprietary Plugs (e.g. CHAdeMo, Tesla)	Up to 50%	Up to 50%
Non-Proprietary & Proprietary Plugs Collocated (Equal Number of Plugs)	Up to 50%	Up to 90%
Non-Proprietary Plugs (SAE-J)	Up to 50%	Up to 90%

Certain sites are eligible for an up to 100% incentive tier if they meet certain criteria. Incentive dollars will be capped for more expensive projects.

Charging Station Infrastructure Program Process

How it Works

This process can take between 8 and 15 months, so it's important to bring us in as early as possible in your planning.

Step 1. Select

Select the type of charger you want to install and how many plugs it will include.

Step 2. Apply

Apply to the PowerReady Program online at conEd.com/PowerReady.

Step 3. File

After preliminary program approval, file a service request at conEd.com/es.

Step 4. Review

Review any required utility-side work with Con Edison.

Step 5. Sign

Receive your Incentive Offer Letter and sign the Program Agreement.

Step 6. Install

Complete project construction.

Step 7. Close Out

Provide final project documentation and invoices.

Step 8. Get Paid

Receive your program incentive!

Step 9. Report

Provide quarterly reports on your station operations.
